(An appointed, one-year commitment that may be held by either an elected, voting member of the Community Board or a non-voting Community member. Option to extend tenure additional year(s) if the individual and the Board approve.)

Qualifications:

1. Be active in an Emmaus Reunion Group
2. Regularly attend Born Again Emmaus Community Board Meetings and Gatherings
3. Attend Board Training annually (if a Board Member).
4. Protect the intent and integrity of the Emmaus Movement and Model.

Responsibilities:

The duty of the Kairos Liaison to an Emmaus 4th Day community is to promote Kairos as an opportunity for the Emmaus community to serve God in various ways. These service opportunities include but are not limited to prayer, financial support, baking cookies, attending Kairos Closing Ceremonies and serving on Kairos inside and outside volunteer teams.
