COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR – Mary D D’Alessio

Though its intensity is waning, we still live in the wake of a global pandemic. Yet, after months of being held at bay from in-person gatherings, the classroom, the marketplace, sporting events, and life lived out in the open we’re now being called forth to embrace communal living once again and take up those old routines, some of which we realize we’ve actually missed. Yet, perhaps some of us feel that we don’t have within us the “good old life” that once was and we’re not ready to “move up and out.”

I don’t think our hesitancy to embrace life in its fullness is due to laziness, however, but is the result of a kind of malaise, which *Oxford Languages* defines as “a general feeling of discomfort, illness, or uneasiness whose exact cause is difficult to identify.” We might equate malaise with melancholy, despondency, uneasiness, or anxiety to name a few. It’s understandable that malaise might just be coloring our worlds, tricking us into thinking we’re safer and more comfortable staying hidden away.

I think it’s a fair parallel as we think about this to consider the world of florae—our plants, trees, and shrubs who were first assaulted by what some are calling “Snowmageddon,” and that, closely followed by hungry oak leaf roller caterpillars and then record-breaking torrential rains and hail. Those phenomena of nature brought destruction and sometimes death, and initially stole the hope of many gardeners. But, wonder of wonders, life prevails and often startles.

As I look around my yard, I’m surprised, encouraged and delighted to see so many signs of emerging life from the plants and trees I’d chalked off as “goners.” From many hardened mounds of brown, silky green shoots are pushing up. Almost denuded oak branches are sporting tender new leaves. Green waxy leaves are popping out from once bare branches on shrubs. I’m certain that over the long haul, not all will be restored to their pre-freeze grandeur, but some *will* surprise me with healthy growth and flowers and fruit better than before. So, I will be patient and stay my hands from the garden shears and clippers. I will persevere in hope that more surprising life is on the way, and I will trust God.

Brothers and Sisters in Christ let us not give up. Let us not fail in our striving to be the people of God that God has created us to be—out in the world revealing the Father’s glory through our living. Let us push through the malaise and the fear, and live to the full, persevering in all that we do.

Perhaps Paul, in his Second Letter to the Church at Corinth, sums it up as he writes: ⁷“But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. ⁸We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; ⁹persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed... ¹⁸So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. (2 *Corinthians* 4: 7-9,18, *NIV*). Let’s take off all that hinders us from running the race set before us and let us bear much fruit! In Christ’s Joy
