COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR – Mary D D'Alessio

Words have always fascinated me, so when I started receiving unsolicited daily emails from wordgenius.com. I wasn't perturbed. I enjoy their "Word of the Day." Along with the definition comes a short blurb about the word's origin, a graph showing its rising and falling popularity over time, and interesting examples of its use. You can also hear the word spoken, which today I really appreciated because the word was *anagnorisis*. I'd never before seen this word or heard it being used. I learned that *anagnorisis*, from the Greek, is a combination of *ana*, meaning back and *gnorisis*, meaning to make known. It literally means *recognition*. So, in today's use, *anagnorisis* is defined as "the point in a play, novel, etc. in which a principal character recognizes or discovers another character's true identity or the true nature of their own circumstances (my emphasis)." The site noted that the *anagnorisis* is important in many stories—and some reveals are particularly surprising, such as when in "The Empire Strikes Back" Darth Vader's identity is revealed to be Luke Skywalker's father.

That the word of the day—*anagnorisis* popped up in my emails as I was contemplating sharing a dream with you was no coincidence. It was affirmation to share, for I think the dream unveils pertinent truths even though the dream came many years ago. It was vivid, though it played out in black and white and gray images. Somehow, as happens in dreams, I was mysteriously transported to a train station in Nazi Germany. It was nighttime. The train platform was crowded with would be passengers and their families,

Nazi soldiers, and railroad personnel. It was noisy. I was nervous. I was supposed to board the train that would cross the border into safety that night. It was risky to try, and I wondered if I'd make it before the borders were closed. The train whistle blew.

There was great commotion as steam came up from beneath the cars and people hurriedly jostled for position to board. Suddenly a stranger came up to me and handed me a topcoat. "Here," he said, "put this on and don't take it off. Everything you need is tucked inside, just under the lining, right above where your heart is. Remember." So, I put on the coat.

Just as quickly as he'd appeared, he disappeared into the crowd. I got in line and stepped up into the train car. There was standing room only. I could feel the fear as the train began to move slowly forward. It had not traveled far when Nazi soldiers began moving through the car, their automatic weapons slung over their shoulders. Stopping in front of each person, they'd tersely say, "Papers, please. Your papers." As a soldier came nearer, my heart raced; I didn't have traveling papers! I'd be thrown off the train, or worse yet arrested! Then I remembered the stranger's words. "Everything you need is tucked inside. Keep the coat on."

A soldier stood in front of me, his sneering face very close to mine. "Papers, please." Trembling, my hand slipped inside the coat and miraculously my fingers found a slit in the lining; there was something there.

"Papers! I need your papers," the soldier demanded loudly. I handed him what I'd found, not knowing what was printed there. He read them carefully, glancing from the papers to my face and back down again. I tried to look calm and confident. Finally, he handed them

back to me and said with a smirk, "Have a nice trip." I woke up, still feeling the rocking motion of the train, still feeling my heart racing. It was a dangerous journey in dangerous times. Yet, I'd been given a covering that provided all I needed to make it safely to my destination.

So, now is when that word *anagnorisis* (appearing when it did), began to make sense. I'd been remembering that long-ago dream and considering sharing it with you, or not. Suddenly I realized it's filled with "reveals", with *anagnorisis*. We—you and I and everyone in the Born Again Emmaus Community, are on a journey in perilous, fearful times. Though all the changes in the world have been coming gradually, it seems as though everything has changed overnight. Much of what we hold dear is threatened. Our values are being assaulted. We don't recognize the land where we live. However, God knows his plans for this land and for us, and God is sending us out, across all sorts of borders. God has covered us with his protective power, providing everything we need, hiding his treasures close to our hearts. When we remember to listen to God's Holy Spirit, we WILL BE told what to say and what to do. We WILL BE told when not to speak and when not to act. With the enemy sneering in our faces we can be courageous and victorious!
